




What a busy week in Waveney Class. Our theme this week was 'rivers' and our focus book was Mr Gumpy's Outing by John Burningham. Initially we only read the beginning and middle of the story and the children had to predict an ending and write it. We also talked about television programmes that we like to watch and what our grandparents would have watched when they were 5 years old, such as Andy Pandy, Pogles Wood, Bill and Ben, The

Woodentops, and Tales From the Riverbank. We

looked at photos from both old and modern television programmes and compared the differences. We looked at photos of the River Waveney and drew pictures using pastels, Carefully selecting the relevant colours. We also used other resources combined with scrunched tissue paper, such as pastels and paint, to create a river scene. We looked at the book *Moon River* and listened to the song, responding through art by selecting our own resources for drawing and collage.









In Maths we subtracted by jumping back along a number line. We counted groups of animals in 2s 5s and 1os and we eeven counted backwards in 2s 5s and 1os! We investigated odd and even, by sharing animals between two boats.

In Phonics, one group has been revising Phase 3 sounds ear air ure and er and writing words and short sentences in our phonics jotters containing those digraphs and trigraphs. We also learnt to read and write the tricky word have. The intervention group has been focussing on m d and writing CVC words.

The Nursery children have also enjoyed the Mr Gumpy story this week. They sang the action song Row Row Your Boat and drew pictures of themselves in a boat with a friend. The also made ducks using hand shapes.





We had a lovely afternoon of sports on Thursday. Well done to all the children who raced, and thank you to all the parents and grandparents who came to support us.
